
Facilities and management

Walsworth Common is a greenspace which is situated to the north-east of Hitchin on the River Purwell. The site is owned and managed by North Herts Council. Walsworth Common is registered Common Land consisting of a large area of amenity grassland, longer conservation cut grassland, scrub, mature trees, a pond and the River Purwell running along its northern and eastern boundaries.

Facilities on site include two football pitches, a basketball court, skateboard ramp and two children's play areas. Local people use the common for informal recreation including dog walking, exercise and as a walking/cycling route to school and work. With its large area of amenity grassland the common is an ideal area to hold large public events like fairs, festivals, circuses and concerts.



How to get there



By Road: Walsworth Common is located to the east of the town centre of Hitchin and to the north of Puwell Meadows. The common can be accessed from Woolgrove Road the main A505 Cambridge Road and Common Rise. There is a car park available at the entrance off Woolgrove Road opposite Highover Way.

By Public Transport: The site is mile (10 minutes walk) from Hitchin Railway Station. There are bus stops at the entrances on Woolgrove Road and Cambridge Road. For travel details contact Intalink Traveline on 0300 123 4050 or www.intalink.org.uk
