The above Order made on 7<sup>th</sup> November 2024, if confirmed as made, will modify the Definitive Map and Statement for the area by:-

Adding to them a footpath commencing from the public highway, opposite Doebridge Farm, at TL 3300 3306 (Point A on the Order Plan) then east on the northern side of the ditch for approximately 375 metres to meet Sandon Footpath 23 at TL 3337 3312 (Point B on the Order Plan)

If no representations or objections are duly made to the Order, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Hertfordshire County Council, instead of submitting the Order to the Secretary of State may itself confirm the Order. If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment, any representations or objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be sent with it.
